## PRODUCTION

Our manufacturing capabilities include filling 12 oz. PET, 16 oz. PET, 1/2 gallon, and 1 gallon jars, and even 320 gallon totes. We have two 250 gallon steam kettles, three 320 gallon mixers, and two production fill lines. Our cup-filling line allows us to produce 1.5 oz., 2.0 oz. and 4.0 oz. portion cups.
